113 Harbor Way, in the harbor 6:30 - 9:00 PM. The entrance to the meeting room is where the valet parking use to be at.

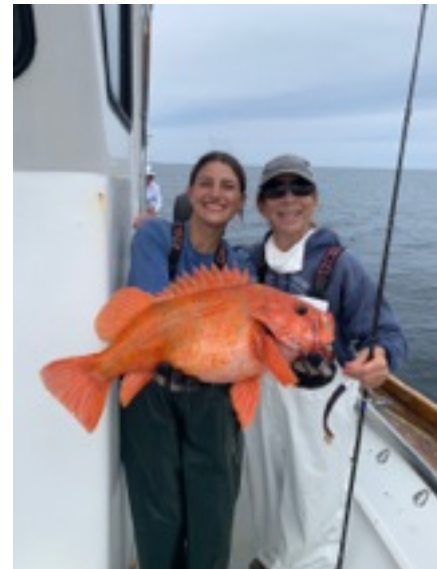
Our Meetings will be held the First Tuesday of every month!

category winner! The May Codeword will be available at the meeting. The June Codeword will be available at the June meeting. This should be a fun tournament.

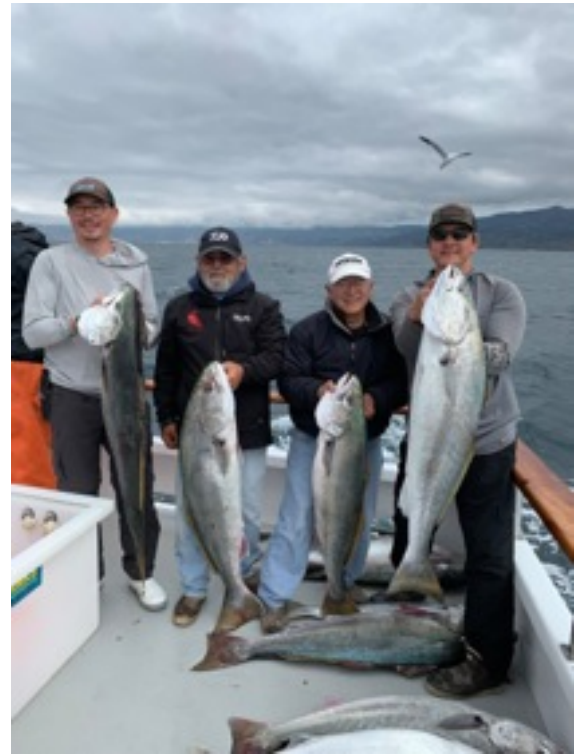
Our Jalama Beach trip was canceled due to rain. We'll discuss if we want to reschedule.
