Reel Fun to Alaska July 19th to 24th 2013 \$1495 per person double occupancy

Clover Pass, Ketchikan, Alaska on the inland passage is on one of the best Salmon runs in the world. These calm waters are the “highway” for Salmon returning to fresh water to spawn. Ketchikan is known as the Salmon Capital of Alaska.

Put a line in the water as you leave the dock and fish for King, Silver, Pink and Chum Salmon.

This is an “all inclusive” trip. Included is your transportation from Ketchikan Airport, self-guided boats, bait, tackle, plentiful meals, fish processing with vacuum pack and quick frozen. Your catch will be boxed and delivered to you at the airport, ready for your trip home to share with friends.

This year Clover Pass is including the 20 foot enclosed Thunder Jet boats with down-riggers and 90 HP outboards. You need only **pay for gas**. Four per boat. You will still be able to use the 14 foot Livingston skiffs, if you desire, at no charge.

What is not included is airfare to Ketchikan, fishing license, taxes, tips and alcohol.

Fish as much or as little as you like in the long summer days, because you are the captain of your boat.

Optional Halibut and Salmon guided charters and float plane trips are available.

When on the water you may see orcas, Whales, and Bald Eagles; they're everywhere. Take some time to visit the historic town of Ketchikan with its many shops, restaurants, and Native Culture.
